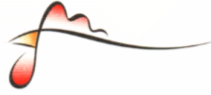

FORM BC 103 PRODUCTION KILOGRAM LEASE FORM

The B.C. Chicken Marketing Board may permit the leasing of a Quota by a Grower, separate from a Production Unit to which the Quota is attached, subject to Part 43 of the August 26, 2011 General Orders, upon terms and conditions as the Board stipulates.

The maximum amount to be leased in/out per period is 50% of a grower's domestic allotment in a specified Period. The following terms will apply:

- (a) The Regulated product leased in by a grower must be contracted to the same processor.
- (b) All Classes of Quota are leased on a live weight kilogram basis within their class;
- (c) Upon receipt of a QPA from the Board office, a grower will have **twenty-eight days** to complete BC 103 Form and return it to the Board office.
- (d) The lessor and lessee of Quota must be Growers who have been allotted Quota by the Board;
- (e) The leased quota must be grown in a registered licensed production unit owned by the Lessee.
- (f) The lessee must have sufficient square footage to accommodate leased quota consistent with General Orders.
- (g) The lease price will be determined between the lessee and lessor and payment made directly between parties.
