**Pricing Order for TC Chicken**

TO: ALL PROCESSORS AND GROWERS

**PRICING ORDER #TC 087**

The British Columbia Chicken Marketing Board orders as follows:

The minimum prices to be paid by Processors to Growers for Taiwanese chicken marketed in the Province of British Columbia on all product contracted for or otherwise designated by the Board to be shipped in the Period A-181 (February 12, 2023 – April 08, 2023) shall be as follows:

- (1) All prices are f.o.b. farm.
- (2) Payment for flocks to be received by the grower 10 days after receipt of the chicken by the processor.
- (3) The targeted weight and/or age shall be as specified on the contract.
- (4) This order shall remain in effect until rescinded, varied or amended by further order of the Board.

*Note: Placement of chicks is day 0; they are not 1 day of age until 24 hours after date of hatch or Placement.*

*Note: Pay age is day of slaughter, not pickup.*

*This means that if the birds are caught at 9:00 p.m. on Monday, but killed at 7:00 a.m. on Tuesday, "pay age" is Tuesday.*
