Re: BCCMB General Orders August 26, 2011 – Amendment

Please be advised that the following amendments have been made to the BCCMB General Orders August 26, 2011. You will find the corrected pages attached only in electronic form (except where noted). Please print and insert them into your General Orders binder and remove and discard the old pages and replace them with the new pages provided as indicated for **Schedule 19, Part 14, and Part 27**. Part 14 Fees and Levies

In this Part the reference to paying the Overmarketing Levy (OML) at rates periodically set by the Board has been removed. It still references Part 27 Overmarketing and Overplacement and Schedule 4 Levies.

Part 27 Overmarketing and Overplacement

This Part has been amended to remove reference to the OML charged to growers every production period from the previous policy. Instead, they now reference the new methodology by where OML's are only collected in the event of a National Overmarketing Levy from CFC. It also directs the growers to the new Schedule 19 – Overmarketing Levy Calculation.

Schedule 19 Overmarketing Levy Calculation

A new schedule has been created to illustrate to growers the methodology by which a grower can calculate the Over Marketing levy they may attract.

These orders are in effect until amended or varied by further order of the Board.
